Publishable extended abstract

The Inter System Interoperability for **TE**tetra-**TE**tropol networks (ISITEP) project is an initiative funded within the EC 7th Framework Programme that aims to achieve a cost effective solution for Public Protection & Disaster Relief (PPDR) interoperability across Europe.

ISITEP aims to develop a global framework where emergency services and first responders share communications technology, procedures and legal agreements with the goal of improving the ability of European PPDR agencies to face natural disasters, security threats (cross border crime activities) and emergencies improving safety and security of European citizens.

During ISITEP project five major dissemination events have been organized, to present to a wider public the aims and the current results of the project, two workshops and three User Fora:

- 1st ISITEP User Forum 24th September 2014 Brussels
- 2nd ISITEP User Forum 24th September 2015 Stockholm
